

HOW TO MAKE A CUSTOM IRIX INSTALLATION ON REALLY SMALL HARD DISKS?

You know the problem... you got a SGI and want to install IRIX on its HDD, but it only has a HDD with 1GB and you still wish to use it. In this case you couldn't do a normal IRIX installation. I'll explain you how to do a customized IRIX installation in inst so that it'll fit on your small HDD.

First of all you only have to use the following CDs of your complete IRIX Major Release set:

- Installation Tools
- Foundation 1
- Foundation 2
- Software Development and Libraries

Then you have to boot with the Installation Tools CD into inst. Within inst you have to use the following commands and parameters:

`keep *`

`install required`

`install default eoe 4Dwm desktop_base x_eoe desktop_eoe netscape`

`keep *.books *.man`

`install prereqs`

`go`

You could also configure it more to your needs. The selections which are done above are just examples

After these steps inst will install the customized IRIX onto your HDD.
